Guest Columnist/Blogger Guidelines

E-mail your article idea/proposal [no attachments please], along with a brief bio to guestblogger@gettogetha.com. Reviews take about one week. If we like your article pitch then we'll contact you.

Get Togetha reserves the right to accept or reject any article submission. You'd be surprised at the type of submissions that are sent to us. Our focus is lifestyle and décor and although broad all it takes is a couple of glances at our blog to gauge what your potential readers make enjoy. When submitting your article we may ask you to make edits for relevance, punctuation and grammar. The better the draft the more likelihood of it being accepted.

At this time guest bloggers will not be paid for submissions.

Images make blog posts pop and are encouraged. Please credit photos.

You as the author will retain all copyrights to your work.

Only unique content will be accepted. There is no guarantee that your article will remain on Get Togetha dot com for any period of time. We, at our discretion can remove or archive articles that are no longer relevant to our readers.

Plagiarism

At Get Togetha we pride ourselves on original content. We love cats; but we hate copycats. We take a firm position on plagiarism and content theft. We do check and run a copyright process on all submissions. So please do not submit work that belongs to someone else. In the book of morals its dead wrong.

What can I do to improve my chances of having my article accepted?

By taking the time to learn about Get Togetha, reviewing our categories, reading our interviews and doing your research. Create an amazing first impression and you shouldn't have anything to worry about. Bad writing happens to everyone but if you think its your darn best then submit it.

Can I substitute an article with a press release?

Can I link my blog/website/product in my article?
